This Year will be held from Friday 27th. September to Tuesday 1st October.

We will return to the same base as last year at The ORCHARDS HOLIDAY PARK, MAIN ROAD, NEWBRIDGE, YARMOUTH. This proved to provide a range of comfortable caravan style accomodation, self catering or make use of an on site "takeaway" facility. Also on site is a licensed shop, swimming pools, pool room, camper van and camping areas. Breakfast available from the takeaway, and meals for three of the evenings of your stay in a dining room also on site. NOTE; there is no licensed bar on site.

For Ferry bookings, you can use the Wightlink discount code as over the page, or avail yourself of the Orchards own discount arrangements with Red Funnel Ferries.

The weekend starts with signing on from 4.00pm at the Orchards, then a "Welcome to our event" and evening meal from 7.00pm on the Friday.

Saturday is the Display day in Newport's St Thomas' Square in the morning, and a ride to some place quaint in the afternoon. Eating arrangements left to entrants. Ask for advice and venues if needed.

Sunday is Scurry Day, a Navigational ride of around 70 miles, with a lunch stop at the 40 mile point. A light buffet meal in the evening, 7.00pm at the Orchards

Monday, and to Cowes and East Cowes, for visits to the two parts of the Island's Boat Museum, the Boat Shed in the morning, and the Gallery in the afternoon. Meals for today again left to entrant's choice.

Tuesday is the turn of the Isle of Wight Aviation museum at Sandown Airport, with a light lunch on sight. A scenic route back to base for an evening meal at 7.00pm followed by presentation of awards and "farewells".

The event will be supporting a local charity once again, this year being the Wessex Cancer Trust, who provide all kinds of assistance including such things as travel etc. for those having to attend clinics on the mainland .

4. A booking will be made (subject to availability) and payment will be required at this stage (by credit card)
5. **A £5.00 admin fee will apply to bookings made by telephone.** The admin fee does not apply to motorcycles bookings

ONLINE:

1. Go to the Wightlink website www.wightlink.co.uk
2. On the Home Page complete bookings details in the 'Start your Booking' box.
3. Complete the booking details requested
4. The Promotion Code **SP19VINT** should be entered on Step 4 in the Promotion Code box, (which is on the bottom of the page). **PLEASE NOTE THAT THE PROMOTION CODE IS CASE SENSATIVE AND SHOULD BE ENTERED AS CAPITAL LET9ERS.** When the code is entered it will re-calculate the price of the booking and take the discount off.
5. Payment will be required (by credit card)

CONDITIONS

Wightlink uses Flexi-Pricing for its public car fares, which means that prices are not static and may increase in line with demand for particular crossings. The sooner a booking is made, the more likely you will be offered a lower fare and prices will generally get higher the closer you get to the sailing date, particularly during busier times. Bookings for this offer must be made and paid in advance. All sailings are subject to availability.
