

You are invited to take part in our 29th Annual South Wales Seaside Run – to be held on Sunday June 4th 2017

Held under a VMCC permit

Aims of the Event. To provide an enjoyable and social seaside run for 2, 3 and 4 wheeled vehicles, their riders and drivers, helpers and spectators.

Event Description. The event is to start and finish, at The Conservative club, Stanwell Road, Penarth. CF64 2EZ. Entrants should sign on from 9.00am. At signing on entrants will receive a number, a suggested route card and a programme. The event route has been extended to North Cornelly again this year. A mixture of 2,3 and 4 wheeled vehicles will commence to leave the start area at 10.00am, on a route of about 75 miles, passing through several well known South Wales seaside resorts and returning through countryside to the starting point at approximately 3.30pm. Concours D'elegance judging will take place during the event and the awards will be presented at a prize giving at approx 4.00pm.

Two beauty spot halts have been arranged en route. They are as follows:-

1. 11.30 - 12.00 at Nash point for coffee.
2. 1.00 - 2.00pm at the Greenacre Pub and Motel, North Cornelly. Entrants may choose to lunch at the Hotel or picnic.

Eligibility. The event is open to VMCC members entering a suitable vehicle manufactured before 31st December 1992. The event is also open to and welcomes non VMCC members with a suitable vehicle manufactured before 31st December 1992.

Awards. Concours D'elegance trophies will be awarded at the finish as follows:-

1. Best Motorcar – The Welsh Water Trophy
2. Best Vintage Motorcycle(pre 1930).
3. Best Post-Vintage Motorcycle(1930-1945) – the Dean Llewellyn cup
4. Best Post-war Motorcycle – the SRM cup
5. Best Three wheeler(inc Motorcycle combinations) – The Brian North cup
6. Best non British Motorcycle – the Barry Cooksley cup.
7. Best Lady Rider
8. Entrants choice of car
9. Entrants choice of motorcycle

A finishers award will also be presented to all those who return and sign off.

Number. A number will be issued at the start which should be attached to the front of the entrants vehicle throughout the event.

Breakdown Vehicle. This will follow the last entrant on the event. If in difficulty please remain on the "course" so that you can be helped. The vehicle will carry a supply of petrol, tools and first aid items along with a trailer.

Greenacres Pub and Motel lunch stop. To assist the pub staff with their catering arrangements, the organisers would appreciate a note on the back of the entry form referring to lunch and numbers required. The pub can offer a good Sunday lunch or bar meals. ***NO MONIES*** should be sent to the organisers as all lunch bills must be settled by each entrant directly with the pub, on the day.

Entries. On the official entry form which must be sent to the event secretary no later than the 30th May, together with the appropriate entry fee of:

£8.00 for solo motorcycles and threewheelers.(£10 on the day)

£9.00 for motorcars.(£10 on the day)

NOTE: Late entries can be accepted on the day but the entrant will not be included in the programme and may not receive a finishers award which has to be pre-ordered for the event.
