ANNOUNCEMENT. The South Wales Section will hold on the above date a non time schedule road run. The event is for solo and sidecar motor cycles, tricycles and three-wheelers and is part of the Western Region championship. The right is reserved, to postpone, abandon or vary the event.

VENUE. The event will start and finish at THE LLANHARRY WORKINGMEN'S CLUB, ELM ROAD, LLANHARRY, GLAM. CF72 9HR.

ELIGIBILITY. The event is open to all riders of machines more than 25 years old, who are fully paid up members of the Vintage Motor Cycle Club Ltd. ALL MEMBERSHIP CARDS MUST BE SHOWN WHEN SIGNING ON.

ENTRIES. Completed entry forms with a fee of £5.00 must reach the secretary by the 6th September 2017. Cheques and postal orders made payable to **SOUTH WALES SECTION, VMCC. YOU MAY OPTIONALLY EMAIL DETAILS OF YOUR ENTRY TO billphelps@john-lewis.com AND PAY THE ENTRY FEE OF £5 ON THE DAY.**

Fees are only refundable if the event is postponed or abandoned. Late entries will be accepted at a £1.00 surcharge. VETERAN MOTOR CYCLE ENTRIES ARE FREE OF CHARGE. Receipt of entry will only be confirmed if an email address is provided.

RIDING NUMBERS. Each rider will be issued with a riding number that must be displayed on the machine and removed immediately after the event.

LEGAL REQUIREMENTS AND INSURANCE. All riders and machines must comply with all RTA requirements. The use of trade plates is not permitted.

CONCOURS D'ELEGANCE. To be eligible for the Concours D'Elegance competition, a machine must have completed the event route.

REPLICAS WILL NOT BE AWARDED.

With the exception of the Concours awards a rider must complete the course to be eligible for a Road Event award.

BONUS MARKS - discontinued from 2017

DESCRIPTION. Route cards and final instructions will be issued at the start. The first rider will leave at 11am and the remainder at one minute intervals. Anyone observed exceeding legal speed limits will be excluded from the event. The route will be approximately 70 miles in length and will be over roads and lanes suitable for your type of machinery and will not include any distressing ascents or descents. A recovery vehicle will be available for the duration of the event. Odometers must be covered from view during the event and any rider failing to do so will incur a 20 point penalty. Please note that there is no time schedule and you may travel at your own speed. THERE IS A LUNCH STOP OF 90 MINUTES. IT IS THE RIDERS RESPONSIBILITY TO START THE AFTERNOON ROUTE ACCORDINGLY.

CONTROL POINTS. A number of control points will be set up on the route and each rider will be expected to stop and answer two questions at these points and also at the finish. The start and finish constitute a control.

PENALTIES. There is no average speed to be adopted or declared by each rider. Instead each rider will be asked questions concerning mileages and average speeds and will lose marks according to the answers. Any rider using another vehicle as a pacemaker will be disqualified. One mark will be lost for each complete minute or mile of an incorrect estimate at the mileages and averages. Any rider missing a control, or failing to stop for the questions, will incur 50 penalty points. Approaching a control from the wrong direction will incur a penalty of 20 marks. Any rider using electronic time, distance or average speed measuring equipment or outside assistance as to the position of controls will be disqualified.
